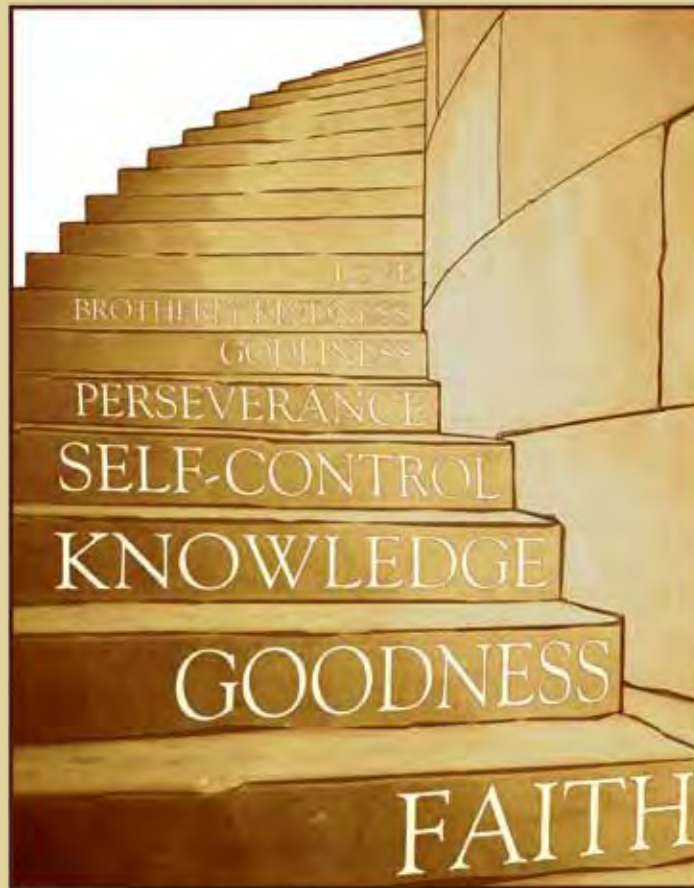

Global economics activated waves of change and uncertainty throughout our nation. Our church family was not spared these realities. Our 2008 annual theme causes us to recognize God's guidance and preparation of us for these unforeseen circumstances. ## FROM THE ELDERS

Dear Chapel Family,

2008 was a watershed year for our family of faith. Let's truly celebrate the wonder of the many changes and blessings that we experienced.

On Palm Sunday, we celebrated our "triumphal entry" into our new Worship Room. In the weeks and months that followed, the new space allowed us to welcome more than 400 new people into our midst. Student Ministries moved into the worship room we vacated. The Student Ministries' team leveraged this resource to provide expanded fellowship, worship, and discipleship opportunities to a growing population of middle school, high school, and college students. Our Children's Ministry flourished in new ways. The Promiseland kids (K – 5th) enjoyed age-specific large group instruction in the room vacated by Student Ministries and two other new, large classroom spaces. Additional new rooms hosted age-specific small group fellowship breakout times. Our Kids' Kingdom and Promisekids children (infant – pre-K) also benefited from more room. And for the first time in years, adults benefited from Sunday morning discipleship and equipping classes (Vine Life).

To more effectively embrace current and future growth, a new ministry structure was formulated and implemented. Though it's not yet fully populated with staff and volunteers, the new structure is already allowing us to function and to manage God's resources better than ever.

In the last quarter of 2008, our country faced economic challenges unlike any in recent memory. The Chapel felt these same pressures, and our staff worked diligently to tighten our belt. The vigor and commitment with which they responded have allowed our ministries to continue to serve our community faithfully.

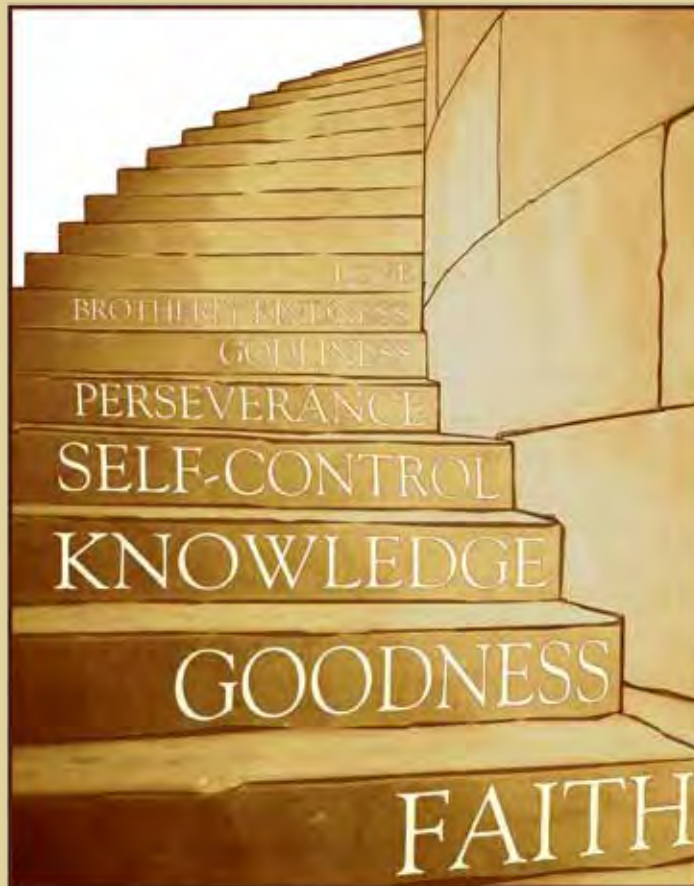

## DID YOU KNOW?

- Since our “Triumphal Entry” into our new facility on Palm Sunday 2008, Jesus has continued to make His “Triumphal Entry” into the hearts of people among us. More than 50 people have “gone public” with their faith through baptism or confirmation of a previous baptism.
- An average of 325 students now attend the combined Middle and High School Worship Service each Sunday morning.
- Additional classroom space has allowed us to once again offer adult education on Sunday mornings. More than 175 adults have attended Vine Life: Adult Discipleship and Equipping Classes this year.

- *Five years ago, the Chapel family set out on a journey of obedience to God's vision for embracing our growth and continuing to make disciples. Today, our expanded bricks-and-mortar facility is physical evidence of God's faithfulness throughout that journey. But have any lives been changed during the journey? On Celebration Sunday, November 2, 2008, simple cardboard testimonies from members of the Chapel family answered that question with a resounding "Yes!"*
- *With our new facility, we were able to invite many more from the community to attend the 2008 Christmas Concerts. We accommodated 50% more guests for the concerts this year than last.*
- *About 4000 of those who attended indicated it was their first visit to the Chapel. We praise God for this outreach to the community - our biggest outreach each year.*

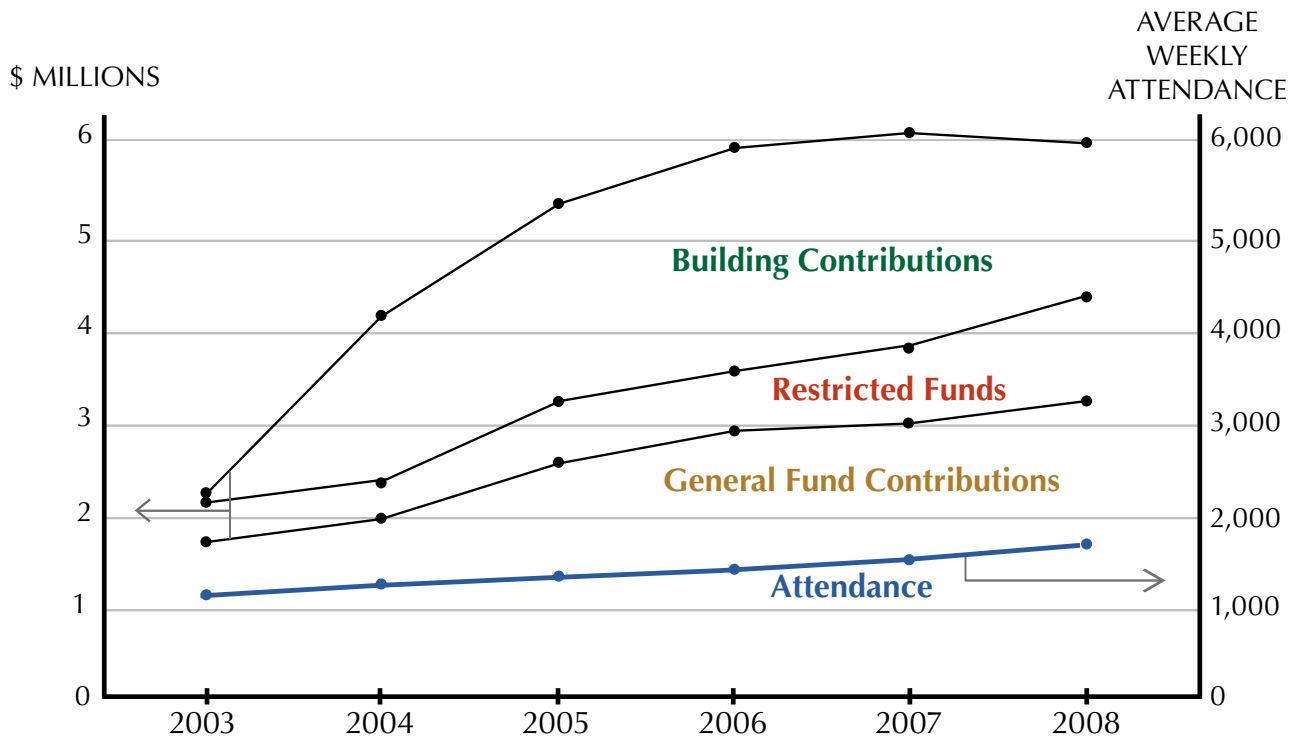

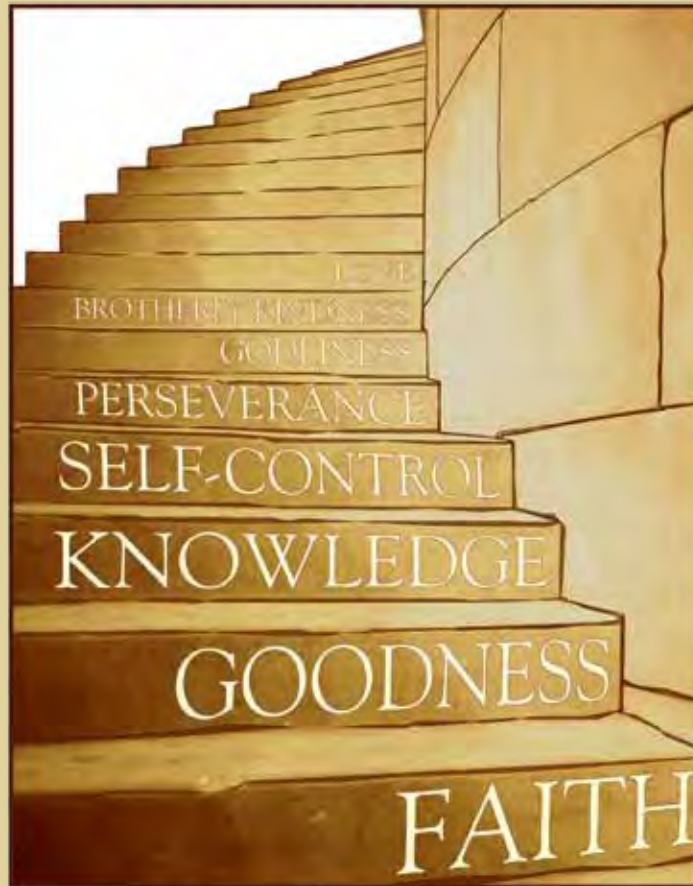
Contributions to Chapel ministries continued to grow faster than attendance. *Building the Church* Campaign contributions totaled \$1.5 million, and the year-end loan balance was \$7,260,788.

### DID YOU KNOW?

- From March 2008 (the inception of the loan for our new facility) until March 2009, we have paid \$947,000 toward the principal balance.
- Additionally, we have paid \$386,000 in interest costs, for a total of \$1,333,000 given to the Building Fund in the past year.
- From March 2008 to March 2009, God added more than 400 new people to the Chapel family. This represents a 19% growth in attendance.
- Use of the Chapel facility for ministry events has increased exponentially in the past year. Several days each week, the Chapel facility is 100% in use, with a ministry activity in every room.
- In the past year, the average number of families or individuals assisted through the Agape Fund has tripled. Praise God for the generosity of His people who give each month to the Agape Fund. The Agape Fund is collected the first Sunday of each month and is used to assist those in need in the Chapel family.

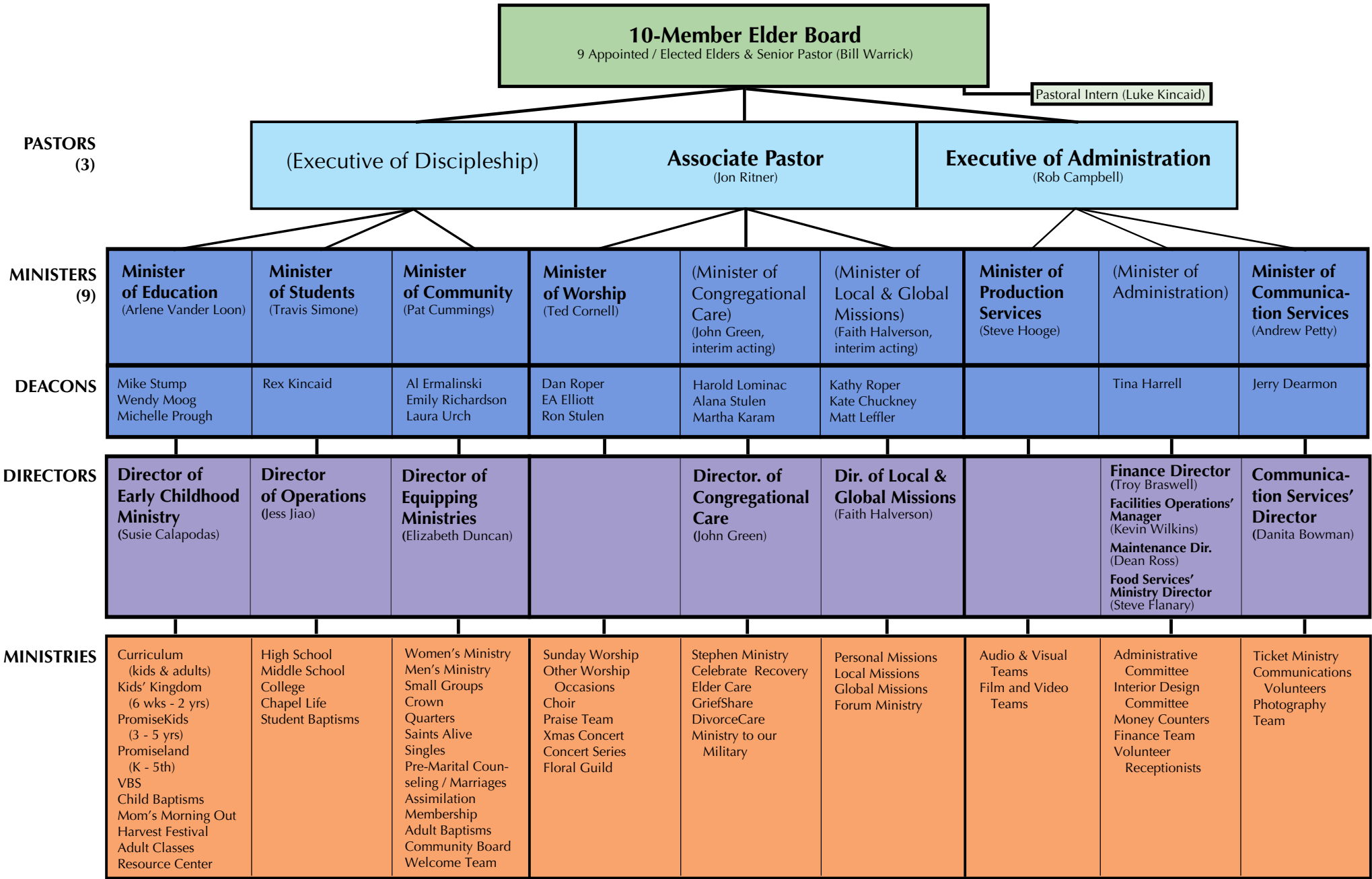
