LOVE & RESPECT:

Tex and Debbie McKinnon's Story

Tex and I had been married for 14 years when we signed up to do the Love & Respect Vine Life class at the Chapel. We both knew that we could use some work on our “communication”, but we also believed (if truth be told) that if the “other one” could just understand HOW their style of communicating was the problem, all would be solved. In our 14 years of marriage we had overcome many obstacles and weathered a lot of storms. Even though both of us had our own relationship with Christ and wanted to put Him at the head of our marriage, our day-to-day interactions left us both feeling misunderstood by each other. I began to feel very disregarded, and resentment began to fester. The irony was that in trying to get my own needs met, I showed a great deal of anger and disrespect in how I spoke to Tex. I am a communication and leadership consultant by profession, and yet I was reacting and speaking very poorly in my own home. The great and frightening thing about belonging to Christ is: you don't get away with that for long.



In the fall of 2010, Tex and I began the 6 week class on Love & Respect. When Emerson began to describe the “crazy cycle”, we could both completely relate. The crazy cycle goes something like this: “When I don't feel loved, I react without respect, and when he doesn't feel respected, he reacts without love”. Emerson went on to show how God's design for marriage is the blueprint for BOTH spouses to truly become a better marriage partner. By understanding Tex's need AND by beginning to find ways to MEET that need, rather than demanding that he understand MY need, I truly felt a peace. NOT because Tex always “earns” it, but because that's God's design for me as an equal yet different marriage partner. I KNOW there are times that Tex does loving things for me because that is what God wants him to do, NOT because I deserve it. Guess what! That truly causes a respect for him like I have never known! We are not perfect, BELIEVE ME...yet we have come a long way and want to continue to grow in our honoring Christ in our marriage.

Emerson has a way of presenting God's Truth in a compelling way. He gives great examples and stories in which we could completely relate. I drug my feet in some ways because I didn't want to hear a marriage course that told me to submit to Tex as the head of the house ... even if that is what God wanted. I just didn't see how I could do it! Emerson defines “submit” and what it means to be “the head of the house” in a refreshing and biblical way that even this old corporate working woman and her independent lawyerly husband totally got!

The best part of all of this is what our kids are able to see that's different in our marriage. All three of them are married and have their own families. We take family trips together, and we are blessed to have great conversations about how important it is to invest in their marriages like they do their bank accounts or any maintenance they do on their home or cars! We are very close, and I know Tex talks to the boys about how they could show love to their wives and serve them in greater ways. I get to talk to the girls as they share with me their family joys and struggles ... and they do share them with me! Those conversations are as a result of listening to them and loving them right where they are, not preaching or giving unsolicited advice. They see the life that Tex and I have together, and hopefully that is the sermon we preach.

If there is goodwill in the marriage, then most conflict is due to a misunderstanding of each spouse's core value. Emerson has taught us that love empowers a husband to energize his wife, and that respect empowers a wife to energize her husband! We've learned what it means to “love” your wife, and what it means to “show respect” to your husband. Ultimately, we need JESUS to empower us to love and respect! The reward is FABULOUS!
